Chancellor, KIIT University (2012-2017); Vice Chancellor National Law School, Bangalore (1997-2000); Founder Vice Chancellor NLU, Jodhpur (2001-2004). Adviser to the Governor of the Reserve Bank of India during (1999-2001) on Financial Sector Law Reform. He was connected with financial sector law reform and developing a strong financial regulatory system in India. His report on reform of SEBI Law (submitted in 2000) led amendment to the SEBI Act to strengthen the Capital market regulator. His report on Bankruptcy law reform; on dealing with Financial fraud by establishing a multidisciplinary Investigation body, SFIO and the report on Creation of effective Security Interest and Priority determination strengthened Monetary regulatory system. His report on Fiscal Responsibility and management ultimately led to an Act to strengthen the fiscal responsibility. During initial years (2006-9) of the Competition Commission of India his role was significant. He was initially a member and then he took over as Chairman of the First Research and Advocacy Group of the Commission. He then joined the first Eminent Persons Advisory Group (EPAG) in CCI and remained a member until he resigned in 2013. Dr. Mitra at different times advised on multiple of subjects to various Ministries of the Government of India.
